The beautiful building now known as Hagan's Tavern was built around 1785 to serve as a public house for travelers on The Olde National Pike, which was the main thoroughfare between Baltimore and Cumberland and from there, the frontier. Hagan's was one of many taverns on the pike, but kept a reputation for having the best food, thereby attracting gentry as well as drovers.

Today Hagan's Tavern upholds its reputation for having the finest food and drink in area. The entire staff dresses in period attire to help maintain the spirit. Their goal is to be renowned for not only having the finest Bill of Fare, but also to provide their guests the friendliest, warmest, and most gracious service on the Pike.

Local artists have adorned the interior walls of the tavern with glimpses of the styles of Moses Eaton, Rufus Porter as well as the Zuber School of 18th Century wall covering. This unique display of artwork is only one of the many details of Hagan's Tavern that creates a romantic atmosphere for its guests.
